HOW IT WORKS

Simply present your active YMCA membership card and photo ID at any participating Ohio YMCA and enjoy free access. See important Program Details below.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- The Reciprocal Membership Program is valid for YMCA full facility/full privilege members only.
- Program-only participants may upgrade to a full membership at any time to qualify.
- SilverSneakers/Prime members may use other SilverSneakers/Prime locations at any time.

- Visitors to other Ys must present a valid YMCA membership card and photo ID upon the first visit and complete a visiting member waiver or standard membership application form with liability waiver.
- YMCA full facility/full privilege members must use their home branch at least 50% of the time.
- Program discounts do not apply.
- Participating YMCAs reserve the right to restrict facility or program access.
- **NOTE: The Lakota Family YMCA follows the restrictions established by our neighboring YMCA's.** To find out what restrictions apply at the YMCA you wish to visit, SEE page 2 and 3 for contact information.

LAKOTA YMCA RESTRICTIONS

- On first visit to Lakota Family YMCA, come to the Welcome Center with your membership card and photo ID to complete a visiting member waiver form.
- Visiting youth members under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult anywhere in the building. Children 16 and older may watch a sibling reciprocal member under the age of 10.
- Visiting members are welcome to use our facility; however, they may not bring non-member guests.
- Child Watch is limited to 2 hours per day and we require members stay on the premises.
- Those using our swimming pools with children ages 0-5 will need to be in the water with the child(ren) within arm's length at all times. Children ages 6-12 will receive a color coded wrist band and must stay in shallow water areas unless they are 45 inches tall and pass the deep water swim test. Swim test will be given at the discretion of the Aquatics Director.
